How to Navigate a Tapestry

NAVIGATING THROUGH NODES

To navigate a tapestry, you will simply need to press on any node you would like to navigate to, which will enlarge that node. The increase in size of the node indicates which node is selected. To view your piece of content, once the node is selected, press on its media icon.



HOW TO VIEW CONTENT



1 To view content in a tapestry, first select the node you wish to view by clicking on it. Once the node is selected, click on the media icon at the top of the node.

2 If the node does not have a media button at the top, simply click on the node to select it (it will become larger than the others), then click on it again to open it.



3 A panel will appear in front of you where you can interact with and view that node's content.



To navigate back to the full tapestry view, simply click outside this panel, or hit the "X" button in the top right corner.

HOW TO OPEN THE NODE SIDEBAR

The node sidebar houses information about any given node within the tapestry. To open the node sidebar:

- 1 Press on any node in the tapestry.
- **2** Press on the right-hand arrow button.
- **3** View information about the node, such as its title, description, and references.



HOW TO CHANGE YOUR DEPTH

You can also use the depth slider on the top-right corner of the page to change the number of nodes visible, or the depth of your tapestry. By moving the depth slider to the left, you will decrease the number of nodes visible. By moving the depth slider to the right, you will increase the number of nodes visible.
